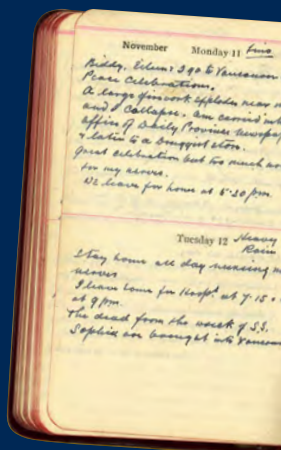

Along with a 'behind the scenes' look at North Vancouver's archives, students will analyze original photographs and documents, assess the reliability of sources, and gain practical experience in accessing archival information.
