### Moodyville: Milltown to Mystery

Grades 4 and up

Learning history is about *doing* history. Our Museum Educator will introduce your class to North Vancouver's once thriving community of Moodyville and guide them on an investigation of the unique stories behind this nationally significant mill-town. Working in groups, students will decipher old photographs, examine artifacts and analyze archival documents to reveal how natural resources and early immigration shaped this country.

**Time:** THREE 60-minute in-class sessions presented by the Museum's History Interpreter.
