## IN YOUR CLASSROOM



### First Nations Community Kit

Grades 4 and 5

It is said that 'a picture is worth a thousand words' but how do we actually learn from photographs? Using images from the North Vancouver Archives' collection, students will explore First Nations themes and stories. The photographs feature local landscapes and individuals. Students will learn to analyze each image and to record relevant observations while learning aspects of First Nations culture. Topics include family life, education and art. The Kit includes lesson plans which encourage team work, group discussion and critical thinking.

**Location:** In Your Classroom

**Offered:** October to May

**Fee:** \$30 Plus \$50 damage deposit. (2 separate payments to be made at the time of pickup).

**Format:** Archival photographs plus lesson plans are provided. This Kit is designed to complement the Grades 4 & 5 Social Studies Prescribed Learning Outcomes and to encourage use of Historical Thinking Concepts. The selected photographs were reviewed by the Squamish Nation Elders and Language Authority as part of the NVMA exhibition, "The Squamish Community: Our People and Places".

Teachers may pick-up and return the Kit to the Community History Centre, 3203 Institute Road. The Kit may be booked for a two week loan period.
