Squamish Community: Our People and Places Kit

Grades 3 to 5

It is said that 'a picture is worth a thousand words,' but how do we actually learn from photographs? Using images from the North Vancouver Archives' collection, students will explore First Nations themes and stories. The photographs feature Squamish landscapes and individuals. Students will analyze each photo while learning aspects of Squamish culture. Topics include family life, education and art. The Kit encourages team work, discussion and critical thinking.

Format: Archival photographs plus lesson plans are provided. This Kit is designed to complement the Grades 3 to 5 Social Studies content and to encourage use of Historical Thinking Concepts (curricular competencies). The selected photographs were reviewed by the Squamish Nation Elders and Language Authority as part of the NVMA exhibition, "The Squamish Community: Our People and Places."
