This large-format, illustrated book and Teacher's Package look at the history, traditions and culture of the Squamish and Tseil-Waututh peoples. Written by Squamish language teacher Khelsilem, the book highlights significant aspects of traditional and contemporary cultures.

The Kit includes lesson plans for intermediate/secondary levels which encourage discussion and critical thinking at all grade levels. Also available in French: *Le livre des peuples autochtones à Vancouver Nord*.

**Format:** The Kit comes with one hardcover copy of the book as well as an electronic copy of it, 22 laminated pages from the book, and lesson plans for intermediate/secondary grades.

**Fee:** \$30 plus \$50 damage deposit. Pay by credit card, cheque or cash at the time of pickup.
