Through images and activities, students will explore the life and legacy of Tsleil-Waututh Chief Dan George. Themes include the significance of his acting career, activism and his efforts to preserve local Indigenous traditions. The Kit includes lesson plans which encourage discussion and critical thinking.

Format: Archival photographs plus lesson plans are provided. This Kit is designed to complement the Grades 3 to 5 Social Studies content and to encourage use of Historical Thinking Concepts (curricular competencies).

Offered: October to May

Fee: \$30 plus \$50 damage deposit. Pay by credit card, cheque or cash at the time of pickup.
